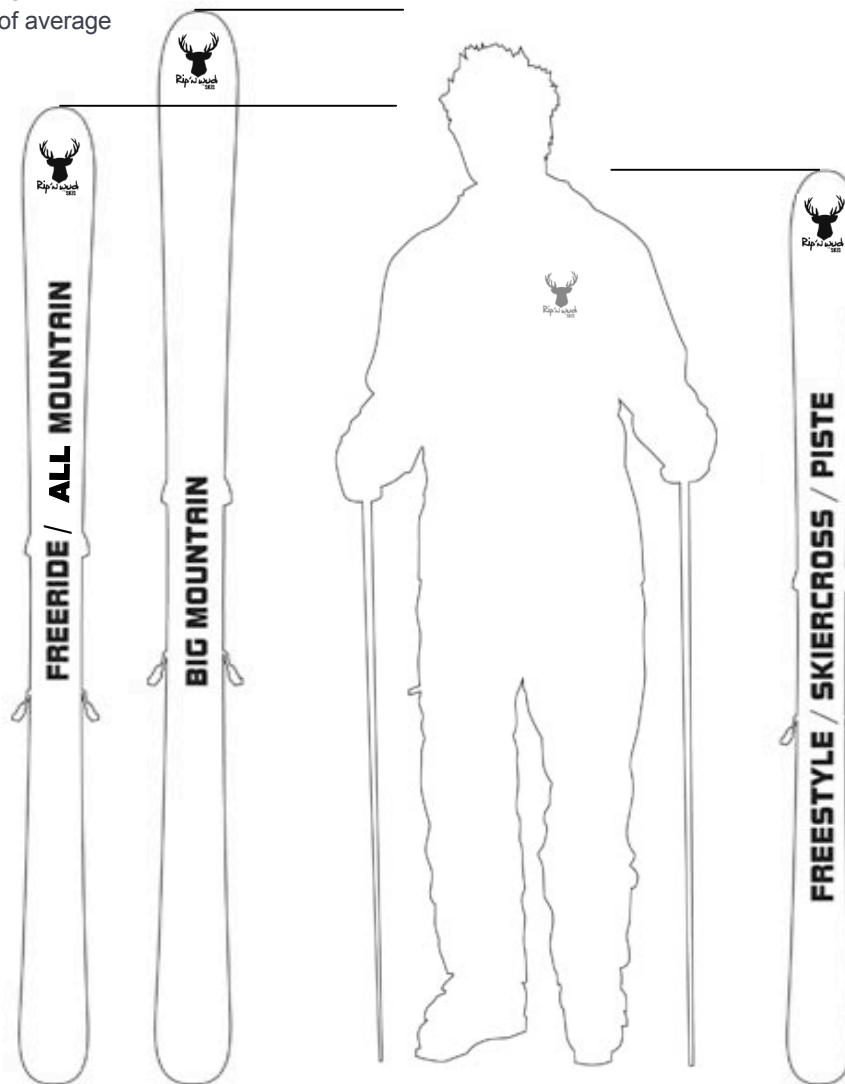


Ski Length, A Rough Guide to Sizing

The simple visual aid below will provide an estimate to the length of each ski category for a recreational skier of average height and weight.

Sizing reference

To obtain a more specific ski length, please refer to the chart underneath. It is also necessary to adjust the length for your ability level and aggressiveness. Please use this chart as a guideline only.

For Freeride skis add between 5 and 10cm in length for better flotation and stability in powder.

Ski Servicing

Serviced regularly, your skis will not only perform better but also last longer. How often your skis need servicing will depend on the snow conditions and the terrain skied.
